



Publishing Policy

International Conference on Technological, Educational, Social, and International Challenges in the Changing World

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The Publishing Policy aims to establish a framework of ethical guidelines for authors contributing to the Conference Proceedings.

Authors are expected to submit original, high-quality papers that has not been previously submitted to any other conference or journal. The corresponding author is responsible for actively participating throughout the publication process and coordinating with co-authors (if relevant) to approve the final submission. Detailed guidelines for authors outlining the essential requirements for full papers are accessible on the conference website and should be considered and followed.

All submissions undergo rigorous double-blind peer review. Upon receiving positive feedback from both reviewers, authors are required to address any suggested minor or major revisions and resubmit the revised manuscript to the editors. The corresponding author is responsible for maintaining communication with the editors throughout the process and following instructions from both reviewers and editors to ensure that all necessary changes are completed.

Should a submission receive two rejective reviews, it will not be considered for publication. In cases where only one review is unfavourable, a third review will be obtained. If the third review is supportive, the paper may proceed to publication. Authors accept that the final decision on publication is made by the editors.

Additionally, authors agree to sign the publishing agreement for inclusion in the Conference Proceedings, thereby affirming their commitment to the standards of publication ethics.
